

# Level 2 Diploma in Health and Social Care (Adults) for England

This qualification develops the knowledge and skills needed when working with adults in health and social care environments. It covers a wide range of areas including supporting individuals with their physical and emotional care, daily living needs and health care procedures. It has three pathways:

## Generic Health and Social Care Dementia                      Learning Disability

The programme is designed for anyone who wishes to work, or who are working in, a supervised role with adults in health and social care.

You will complete the 9 mandatory units, and a selection of optional units suited to your area of work. The mandatory units are:

- Introduction to communication
- Introduction to personal development
- Introduction to equality and inclusion
- Introduction to duty of care in health
- Principles of safeguarding and protection in health and social care
- The role of the health and social care worker
- Implement person-centred approaches in health and social care
- Contribute to health and safety in health and social care
- Handle information in health and social care settings

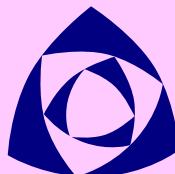
