Entry 3 - City and Guilds

Functional skills English equips you with the basic practical skills required in everyday life, education and the workplace. You will learn in a group and develop the transferable skills you will need to be successful. The course includes 3 assessments:

- . Writing (40 Minute assessment)
- . Reading (40 minute assessment)
- . Speaking and Listening – to be observed participating in 2 class discussions – One on a familiar subject and one on an unfamiliar subject.

All of which have to be passed to achieve the full qualification. The sessions are 3 hours per week and last for 20 weeks.

After the Course

Improving your English skills will make you more confident and as you progress through the levels you will be building on your skills to enable you to use correct, grammar, spelling and punctuation. Progression routes are available to progress to GCSE.

Entry Requirements

Acceptance onto the course is by assessment. Learners need to bring evidence of prior attainment. Please ring Forster Community college to arrange an assessment.
