Level 2 – City & Guilds

The Functional Skills maths qualification equips learners with the basic practical skills required in everyday life, education and the workplace. You will learn in a group and develop the transferable skills you will need to be successful. The course is divided into three units:

- Number (including fractions, decimals and percentages)
- Measures and metrics
- Handling Data (including charts and graphs)

Achieving this qualification will increase your confidence and practical skills, which will be valuable in the workplace or in any further learning. The course is delivered in the morning and afternoons. Each class lasts for 3 hours. After the initial assessment, on-going assessment will continue throughout the course. Students will be required to undertake formal exams at the end of each course when they are ready. This will be in the form of a timed exam, where students will be allowed the use of a calculator.

After the Course

Improving your maths skills can make you more confident and open the way to more job opportunities, training and further study. Upon successful completion learners may wish to progress on to GCSE Maths or any other course of interest in Further Education or Higher Education.

Entry Requirements

Acceptance onto the course is by assessment. Learners need to bring evidence of their highest English and/or maths qualification. Please ring Forster Community College to arrange an assessment. If you have passed Level 1, you will automatically be able to access the course.
